This is an amazing opportunity and will allow you to gain a very unique work experience-the kind that professionals in every field agree provides students with skills they need to compete effectively in today's job market.

Below is a description of the responsibilities involved with a/an Quick-Service Food & Beverage role:

There are more than 250 Quick-Service Food & Beverage locations throughout the WALT DISNEY WORLD® Resort. High volume and Guest contact are key parts of this role. Cast Members in this area will work independently or as part of a large team in either indoor or outdoor locations. Responsibilities may include: taking orders, operating a point-of sale system (cash register), cash handling, filling food and beverage orders, dispensing and selling alcohol, heavy lifting, pushing and pulling, emptying waste cans, general cleaning with chemicals and food preparation.

In order to maintain a safe and healthy environment and comply with Florida state-mandated regulatory food standards, all Cast Members hired to work in any Merchandise or Food and Beverage establishment that prepares and/or serves food and beverage, regardless of role, are required to:

- *Keep fingernails trimmed and filed (not extended beyond the tip of the finger).*
- *Not wear fingernail polish and/or artificial nails.*
- *Not wear jewelry on arms or hands, including wristwatches and medical information jewelry. The exception is a plain (commitment/wedding) ring, without stones, engravings, raised designs or jagged edges. Acceptable options for medical jewelry include necklaces and ankle bracelets worn under costumes.*

The position requires your commitment to work for a period beginning 6/23/2010 through 9/3/2010. Your arrival date in the United States is 6/20/2010. Your pay rate will be \$7.56 per hour.

You will be responsible for all visa processing fees charged by the United States Embassy/Consulate as well as any transportation costs or postage required for such processing. **IMPORTANT:** Upon arrival in the United States, you must present your original DS-2019 form and your valid passport for entry into the United States in J-1 visa status.

Medical care in the United States can be quite expensive, medical insurance is a requirement to participate on this Program. It is **mandatory** that you insure yourself for the duration of your program, and you must provide proof of insurance upon your arrival in Orlando.

As part of the employment process, please make sure that you have completed a background check and that the information has been submitted to your Procurement Ally no later than thirty (30) days before your departure. Failure to provide the results of this information prior to your arrival will result in the cancellation of your participation on the program.
